




TRENDERED FLOOR PLAN

#### SCOPE OF PROJECT:

SANZFORMATION was hired to redesign and renovate the Boomer's Residence. Carefully taking into account client profile and requirements, The project included a redesign of the kithchen and laundry area, as well as other areas of the home that would help the client improve their quality of life and allow them to "age in place". In order to achieve this, universal design concepts and ADA requirements were considered and incorporated when planning and designing each space, and in the process of furniture and appliance selections as well.
